



## Carolyn Elmore Gordon

March 27, 1928 - January 15, 2022

Carolyn Elmore Gordon, Age 93, passed away on January 15, 2022, at Life Care Center of Bruceton, where she had been a resident since April 2021.

A Camden native, Carolyn was born on March 27, 1928, to John D. Elmore and Fannie Watson Elmore. She graduated from Camden High School in 1945 and had maintained a relationship with fellow graduates throughout the years, attending annual school reunions as long as her health permitted.
